
This is a second notice and contains updated information based on feedback received from residents on Far West Boulevard.

In order to improve safety for all modes of transportation, the City's Public Works Department is implementing and improving a bicycle route system, as directed by the Austin City Council per **City Ordinance No. 20090611-075 (The Austin Bicycle Plan)**. Far West Boulevard from Mesa Drive to Chimney Corners is part of Route 22 of the City of Austin bicycle system. You are receiving this notification because you live on and/or own property adjacent to Far West Boulevard in Austin, Texas, and/or are a stakeholder in the area.

In coordination with routine street maintenance (road re-surfacing and re-striping), and to enhance mobility in the corridor for both motor vehicles and bicycles, the street striping will be reconfigured to modify parking and improve existing bicycle lanes. To accomplish this reconfiguration, on-street motor vehicle parking will be prohibited on certain sections of Far West Boulevard. The updated parking modifications shown below in Figure 1 are a result of input received from residents on Far West Boulevard. Note that parking will now be allowed on the north side of the street between Montana Norte and Northledge Drive. This update results in more total parking spaces, improved access to existing sidewalks, and more convenient on-street parking for the townhomes on the north side of Far West Boulevard.


- **Far West Boulevard** (from Mesa Drive to Montana Norte) – prohibit parking on the north side of the street.
- **Far West Boulevard** (from Montana Norte to Northledge Drive) – prohibit parking on the south side of the street.
- **Far West Boulevard** (from Northledge Drive to Chimney Corners) – prohibit parking on the north side of the street.

The dashed line in Figure 1 does not indicate the location of bicycle lanes; it only indicates no parking areas. As indicated in Figure 1, parts of Far West Boulevard (from Mesa Drive to Chimney Corners) will have permitted parking on only one side of the street. These locations will have bicycle lanes in both directions and will also have a parking lane on one side of the street as shown below in Figure 2.
