As part of our commitment to provide high quality and reliable water and wastewater service, Austin Water is making plans to replace or rehabilitate water and wastewater lines in your area.

The project, known as the Brentwood Water and Wastewater Renewal Project, is expected to begin construction in early summer 2020. Construction is expected to take nearly 2 years to complete.

Austin Water will hold a public meeting once the contractor has been hired and before construction begins next year. At that time, we will be able to answer your questions about construction phasing, traffic control plans and generally what to expect.
