

Boggy Creek – East MLK Storm Water Conveyance Improvements Phase 2

Dear neighbor,

The City of Austin Public Works Department is implementing phase two of a storm water infrastructure improvements project that will take place in the Chestnut neighborhood north of E Martin Luther King Boulevard and east of Alexander Avenue. The project will reduce the flooding risk for homes in the area and upgrade utility infrastructure.

We would like to offer you the opportunity to meet the contractor and the City of Austin project team prior to construction. We plan to have a virtual meeting with residents to explain the project, construction impacts and answer questions you may have. Details for a virtual meeting will be provided online and in a separate notice.

PROJECT FEATURES

- New storm drain system from Walnut Avenue to Alexander Avenue
- Water and wastewater pipeline installation
- Underground manufactured water quality units
- Roadway and utility improvements

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Travel on MLK Blvd. between Alexander Ave. and Boggy Creek will be temporarily reduced to one lane in each direction. Traffic detour signs and barricades will help direct traffic. Bus routes may be detoured.
- Sometimes water will need to be shut off during the project. The inspector will notify residents 48 hours before scheduled shut-offs along with a time-frame for the shut-off.
- The project will take approximately 19 months to complete, weather permitting. There will be noise, dust and vibrations from construction during working hours.
