**Project Name:** Country Club Creek Trail Improvement

**Applicant:** South East Austin Trails and Greenways Alliance

**Project location:** Elmont Drive and Guerrero Park



### Project Scope & Description

- Project will resurface a portion of the Country Club Creek Trail between Elmont Drive and Guerrero Park with high quality crushed decomposed granite road base. City of Austin will be providing and compacting the materials, as well as cutting and filling as necessary.
- Project feasibility has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate staff at the Parks and Recreation Department and the Watershed Protection Department.


