
Street Mural Painting Completed in 2012 and the Mural Today





Traffic Circle Concept






Project Name: Salina/22nd Traffic Circle

Applicant: Blackland Community Development Corporation

Project location: E. 22nd St. and Salinas Street





Project Scope & Description

- Project will construct a traffic circle at the intersection of 22nd and Salina Street. The project includes the
 installation of a concrete apron and a place for plantings. Project also includes touching up the existing
 sunflower street art mural painted previously at the intersection.
- Project feasibility has been reviewed and approved by staff at the Austin Transportation Department.



- Project is in the Upper Boggy Creek
 Neighborhood Planning Area. Project partially
 implements an updated Recommendation #78
 which includes requesting a roundabout at 22nd
 and Salina. This recommendation was the #2
 priority for this neighborhood planning area in
 FY 2013-14.
