



# 2016 Mobility Bond: Urban Trails

## Country Club Creek Trail Riverside Drive to Oltorf Street

### OVERVIEW

Country Club Creek Trail will link completed portions of the trail to the north and south, providing a continuous connection from Roy G Guerrero Park to Mabel Davis Park.

### PROJECT PURPOSE

This project will complete the Country Club Creek Trail by constructing a 0.6-mile section that connects Riverside Drive to E. Oltorf Street with a 12-foot wide ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act)-accessible path.

The completed trail will provide a continuous three mile trail to parks, residences, shopping, and transit in southeast Austin.

### FUNDING

- \$7.1 M from the 2016 Mobility Bond

### ANTICIPATED TIMELINE

- **Planning Phase:** Spring 2013-Winter 2014
- **Design Phase:** Winter 2015-Spring 2020
- **Anticipated Construction:** Summer 2021-Winter 2023

### 2016 MOBILITY BOND
