URBAN TRAIL GOALS



- **1.** Easy **access** to transportation + recreation users from all parts of the City
- 2. **Connect** to on-street bicycle + sidewalk networks
- **3. Adequate width** to accommodate transportation + recreation users
- **4.** Include **trail amenities/features** that create unique greenways
- 5. Adequate funding and resources to maintain + operate
- 6. Context-sensitive, environmentally sustainable, preservation + improvement upon wildlife habitat






URBAN TRAILS PLAN


- Brookswood Ave to Jain Ln


Existing Path



ALTERNATIVE 1



- Route currently used by Eastside Memorial
 High School Students
- Connects to Southern Walnut Creek Trail
- Majority of trail located within City of Austin property
- Convenient tie-in with Capital Metro Bus route at Sara Drive and Prock Lane






ALTERNATIVE 2



- Connects neighborhoods on both sides of Austin Area Terminal Railroad tracks
- Least environmental impact
- Farther from Eastside Memorial High School






ALTERNATIVE 3



- Farthest from current main student route
 (add ½ mile to school route)
- Connects to Southern Walnut Creek Trail
- Greater potential impact on trees along route






LOTT AVENUE CONNECTION



• **Option 1:** 450 linear ft of trail connecting Eleanor Street with Lott Avenue.

• **Option 2:** 400 LF of trail connecting Lott Avenue with Fort Branch Blvd.






FEEDBACK AND NEXT STEPS





- Alternative 1: Sara Dr to Southern Walnut Creek Trail
 - **Cost:** \$5.25 million
 - 2,500 linear ft
- —— Alternative 2: Brookswood Ave to Jain Ln
 - **Cost:** \$4.67 million
 - 300 linear ft (and sidewalk improvements)
