
PROJECT OVERVIEW



- First public meeting held






• City staff are developing a Preliminary Engineering Report to identify a recommended route and project considerations like environmental concerns, wildlife, nearby property



Recommended Trail Features


- 10-12 ft wide concrete trail

- Safer connections through neighborhood and to Eastside Memorial High School and Southern Walnut Creek Trail


Preferred Route Alternatives







- Majority of trail within City of Austin property






