



2016 Mobility Bond: Urban Trails

Northern Walnut Creek Trail Section 3

IH-35 to Southern Walnut Creek Trail

OVERVIEW

Northern Walnut Creek Trail Section 3 is part of the Walnut Creek Trail System, a 19-mile high priority regional trail network. This project will connect Northern Walnut Creek Trail at IH-35 to Southern Walnut Creek Trail.

PROJECT PURPOSE

A Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) is being created for Northern Walnut Creek Section 3. The PER will identify a recommended route and project considerations like environmental and wildlife concerns, nearby property ownership and more.

No design or construction funds are currently allocated for this project, but having a plan ready allows the City to move forward quickly, if funding is identified.

Staff are working to identify funding opportunities for continued development of this project.

ANTICIPATED TIMELINE

- **Fall 2017:** Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) process begins
- **Spring/Summer 2018:** First PER draft prepared and first public meeting held
- **Winter/Spring 2019:** Environmental Field Inspections performed; Environmental Assessment & Resource Inventory finalized
- **Summer 2019:** Archaeological report finalized; Texas Historical Commission approval received
- **Fall 2019:** Second public meeting held; final PER to be released in mid-Nov. 2019.

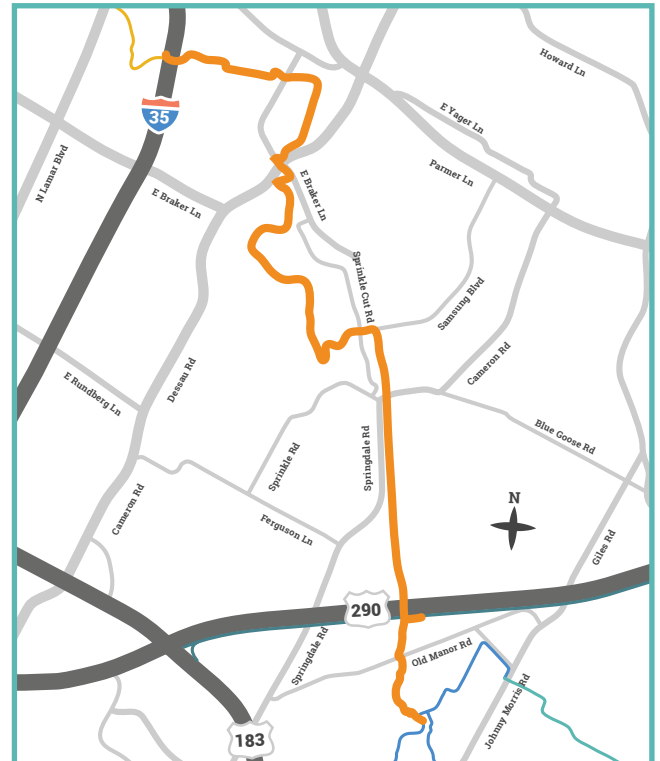
FUNDING

RECOMMENDED ROUTE



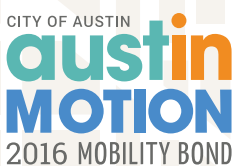
