




PHASE 2 360 SEGMENT

The Loop 360 segment is nearly complete with the new pathway lighting and landscaping, which was installed in the Spring. Currently our construction teams are finalizing the installation of the protective railings so that the trail can open later this year. This section of the trail is open for use by cyclists and pedestrians. Temporary fencing has been set up along this segment. However, by October of this year the trail will have to be closed again so that permanent fencing can be installed.
