



2016 Mobility Bond: Urban Trails

Violet Crown Trail – North Home Depot Boulevard to MoPac

OVERVIEW

Violet Crown Trail – North is a one-mile section of the Violet Crown Trail that extends from Home Depot Boulevard to Mopac, just north of William Cannon Drive.

PROJECT PURPOSE

Violet Crown Trail – North will connect existing portions of the Violet Crown Trail, which will ultimately be a 30-mile trail system that runs from Barton Springs Pool in Austin south into Hays County.

FUNDING

- \$1.177 M from a **Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO)** grant
- \$1.2 M from the **2016 Mobility Bond**
- \$550,000 from the 2012 Bond

ANTICIPATED TIMELINE

- **Planning Phase:** Spring 2014-Winter 2014
- **Design Phase:** Spring 2015-Winter 2019
- **Anticipated Construction:** Fall 2021-Fall 2022
