Q: Can the RFQ be emailed?

A: Yes, email [carrie.brown@austintexas.gov](mailto:carrie.brown@austintexas.gov) to receive the RFQ via email.

Q: Will landscaping be included in the overall project?

A: Yes, Coleman TBG Partners has been contracted to develop landscaping on all sides of the facility.

Q: Will the walkway from the terminal to the CONRAC facility be covered?

A: Yes, the walkway will be covered to shade travelers from the elements. However it will not be enclosed.

Q: What are other examples of successfully integrated artwork into CONRAC facilities?

A: The City of Phoenix hired artist Ed Carpenter before the design team was selected. For more information on this project, visit: <http://skyharbor.com/community/artMuseum.html>.

Q: Will the artist be responsible for producing construction documents?

A: No, Demattei Wong Architecture will be responsible for producing construction documents. However, the artist will work closely with the project team to integrate the artwork into the construction documents.

Q: Will sustainable materials be considered?

A: Yes, the City of Austin encourages the use of sustainable materials in all matters of design however it is not required for this particular AIPP project.

Q: If the artwork is fabricated and installed by someone other than the artist, will the artist's fee for oversight come from the \$140,000 design fee?

A: No, the fee for artist oversight during fabrication and installation will be in addition to the \$140,000 design fee.

Q: Does the design team already have an idea of what type of artwork is desired?

A: No, the design team is open to a wide range of ideas. Possible locations include the pedestrian walkway, open air plaza, entrance lobby and building façade.

Q: How do I submit videos?

Q: Is the lobby of the Customer Service Building (CSB) open air space? Are the rental car counters inside?

A: The lobby of the CSB and the rental car counters are inside. As you walk across the existing parking garage to the CONRAC facility, you are in a covered walkway which leads to an open air plaza. Then, you enter doors into the CSB lobby where the rental car counters are.
