

## Meet Commander Joe Chacon

On May 29, 2016, Austin Police Commander Joe Chacon will assume duties over APD's Region 2 patrol command. Commander Chacon will also take over as the Public Safety Representative (Place 11), on the Restore Rundberg Revitalization Team.

Commander Chacon began his career as a police officer in his hometown of El Paso almost 25 years ago. He has served with the Austin Police Department for the last 18 years. During his tenure at APD, Chacon has served our city in a variety of capacities, including stints as a District Representative in Region 1, Special Investigations Detective, Internal Affairs Sergeant, and Homicide Sergeant. He also served as the department's Staff Lieutenant under Chief Acevedo. Most recently, he served as a Lieutenant and Commander of the APD Intelligence Division. Commander Chacon is very familiar with the Rundberg community, previously assigned within the neighborhood as a Patrol Sergeant in 2007 and as a Patrol Lieutenant in 2011.



Serving the department in multiple capacities has allowed Commander Chacon to gain valuable experience with City Hall and cross-sector partnerships. As Staff Lieutenant and following his promotion to Commander, he facilitated Public Safety Commission meetings, consulted with Public Safety Commissioners, and assisted administrative personnel at City Hall with a variety of issues.

Commander Chacon is committed to problem-oriented policing and strives to collaborate with the community he serves. He regularly attends neighborhood meetings and uses these forums as opportunities to educate the public about the police profession, and to show residents that we are very approachable and are here to help.

"I'm excited to work with the Rundberg community; I have seen the strides that the Restore Rundberg project has made in recent years, and I look forward to continuing that effort. Being Hispanic, I think I bring a fresh perspective to the table, and want to help bring about meaningful progress for our communities of color."- Commander Joe Chacon

He volunteers as a coach and mentor in the Miracle League of Austin, an adaptive Little League baseball organization. He also volunteers with Special Olympics Texas.
