

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

W. Stassney Ln/Lewood Dr and W. Stassney Ln/Buffalo Pass intersections



OVERVIEW

Following a first phase of bicycle infrastructure and signal improvements of Stassney Lane from West Gate Boulevard to South Congress Avenue, Austin Transportation, in partnership with Public Works and Capital Metro, will be implementing multimodal improvements to intersections along Stassney Lane. The proposed changes were developed from community feedback gathered in 2019. The proposed changes are expected to:

- Improve access to transit through new and relocated bus stops.
- Encourage multimodal transportation by improving bicycle, pedestrian, and transit infrastructure.
- Reduce crashes for all modes with increased safety measures.
- Increase accessibility on sidewalks

PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS

- An improved crossing island and new crosswalk on Stassney Ln. at Lewood Dr.
- A new bus stop on the south side of Stassney Ln. at Leewood Dr.
- Curb ramp and sidewalk improvements
- An improved crossing island and new crosswalk on Stassney Ln. at Buffalo Pass

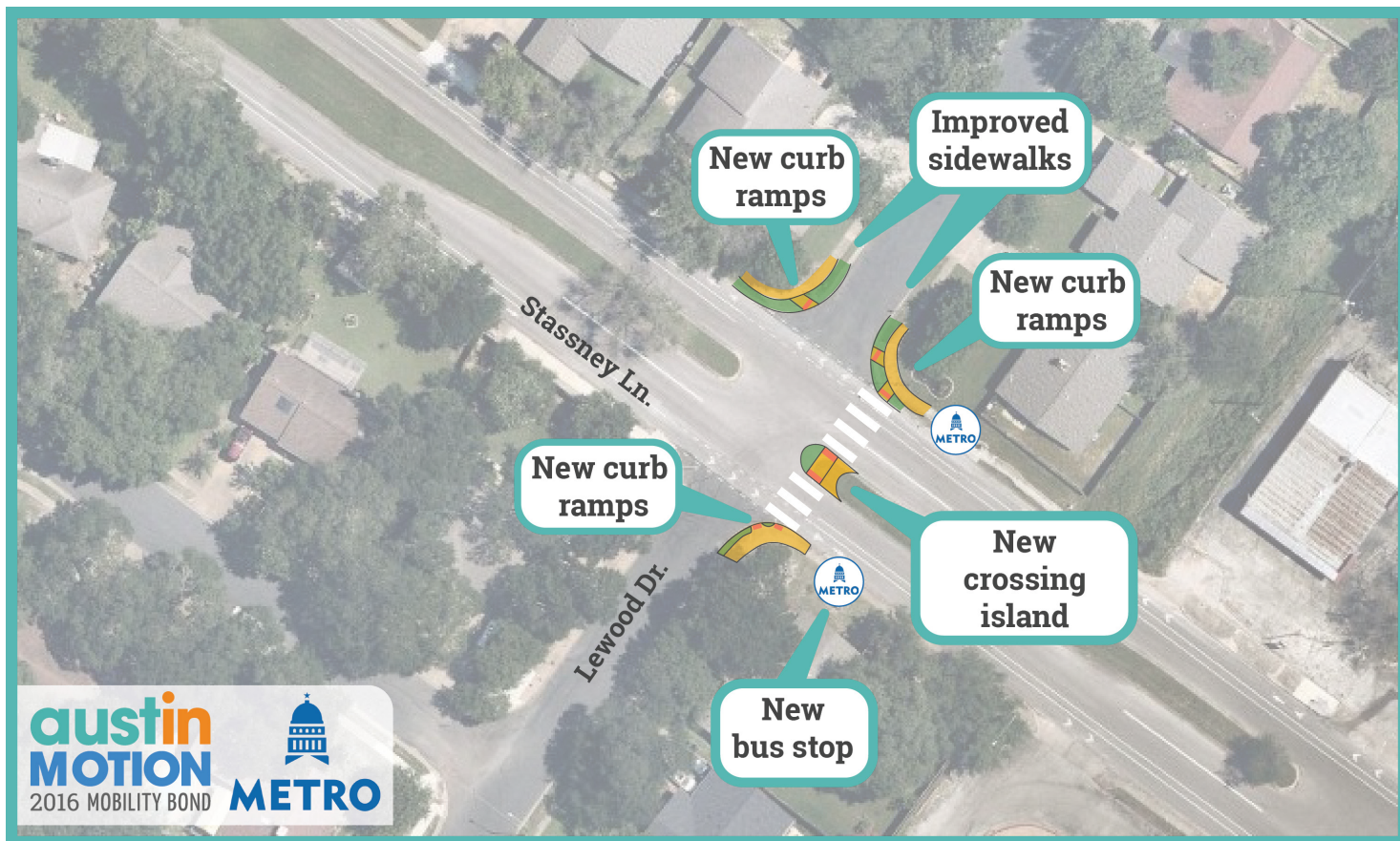
TIMELINE
