

Stassney Lane

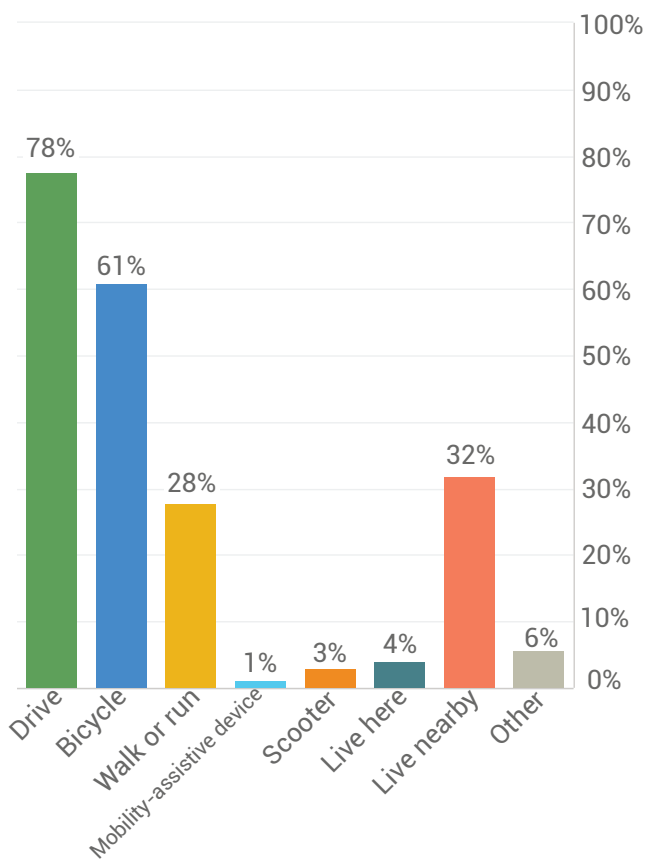
(West Gate Boulevard - South Congress Avenue)

Austin Transportation Department has completed an evaluation of Stassney Lane between Westgate Boulevard and Congress Avenue to improve the safety and mobility for everyone who uses these streets.


As part of this evaluation, the project team reviewed input from **over 600 survey responses** on how people use Stassney Lane from West Gate Boulevard to South Congress Avenue and their level of support for proposed changes. 78% of respondents strongly or somewhat support the proposed changes. What do you like and/or dislike about the proposed changes?

-  Support for improved bike lane protection, both midblock and at intersections
-  Concern about high motor vehicle speeds
-  Support for improved safety, access, and mode choice
-   Concern and support for lane conversion
-  Desire for protected bike lanes and improved pedestrian infrastructure in south Austin
-  Desire to extend project limits east of South Congress Avenue
-   Support and concern about floating bus stops

By the Numbers: proposed changes on Stassney Lane

- 2+ miles of protected bike lanes
- 5 intersection upgrades (improvements to bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure)
- 6 improved bus stops including 2 new floating bus stops
- 2 signal upgrades (improving safety and motor vehicle travel times)
