#### INTERSECTION SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

Barton Springs Road and South 1st Street



### **OVERVIEW**

Austin Transportation Department is developing a project to improve safety and mobility at the intersection of Barton Springs Road and South 1st Street. This project is designed to reduce crashes for all transportation modes, increase safety, and improve mobility and accessibility for those walking, riding bicycles or taking transit.

## PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS

Project improvements include:

- A new raised concrete median on the west side of Barton Springs Road for improved access management.
- Upgraded pedestrian infrastructure, including restriping of high-visibility crosswalks and new Americans with Disabilities (ADA) accessible curb ramps.
- Relocated on-street bicycle lanes to new protected bicycle lanes on both sides of Barton Springs Road at the southeast and northwest corners of the intersection with enhanced visibility treatments.
- New bicycle facilities on the north and south side approaches of S. 1st St. to connect to new eastbound and westbound bicycle facilities.
- Driveway modifications to improve safety for drivers turning in and out of driveways.
- Signal infrastructure upgrades and signal timing upgrades to improve operations.
- An improved Capital Metro bus stop at the northwest corner for safer and improved access to transit.

### TIMELINE

The project is estimated to begin in Winter 2022, barring no weather delays or other unforeseen circumstances.


## **FUNDING**
