

HOW TO OBTAIN A CHAUFFEUR'S PERMIT:

		Nationwide Criminal Record Background Check. Fingerprints are taken by IdentoGO. To schedule an appointment go to uenroll.identogo.com or call 888-467-2080
		IMPORTANT: In order for us to receive your records, you need to give our <u>Service Code</u> : <u>11GYVN</u> to IdentoGO. After you get fingerprinted, there is a wait of 48 to 72 hours before we get the results. Please call us to confirm that we have received your fingerprints before visiting our office. Phone numbers are listed at the end of this guideline. (DO NOT GET FINGERPRINTED AGAIN IF YOU HAVE ALREADY USED THIS SERVICE CODE. CALL OUR OFFICE TO CONFIRM IF WE HAVE YOUR BACKGROUND.)

		If citizenship has been granted, please bring your Naturalization Certificate or USA Passport & Social Security Card.

However, wait to sign your application until you are in front of the notary. If you like for our office to notarize your application, there will be a \$6.00 service fee added to the cost of the Chauffeur Permit.
		Certified Texas Driving Record can be obtained @ <u>www.dps.texas.gov</u> . Please make sure to select <mark>Type 3A – Certified</mark> when npted.
		If your driver's license is less than 3 years old , you will need to bring also a <u>Certified Driving Record from your previous state</u> of residence or proof of at least 3 years Texas residency by bringing a copy of your electric bill, bank statement, income tax return, insurance card, or letter from housing that reflects this. Driving records cannot be older than 30 days.
		If you have any moving violations within the past 3 years, you will need proof of taking a <u>Defensive Driving Class</u> dated after the conviction date of the offense regardless of your driver's license type.
	Ordi <u>Pass</u>	e a Test in our Location. The test will consist of questions pertaining to customer service, traffic violations, landmarks, and inance related questions. To familiarize yourself with our Ordinance follow the link to: Chapter 13-2 Ground Transportation senger Services. Testing is administered Monday through Friday, 8:30am to 11:30 am and we are located at 1501 Toomey Rd. tin, TX 78704.

	obta	For college students, you will be required to show a current year transcript. The permit will need to be renewed annually. You will NOT have to in a Texas driver's license as long as you are enrolled as a student. For people who relocated to Texas, you will have a 90 day conditional permit. After 90 days, you must show proof of a Texas Driver's license a 3A Certified Texas Driving Record in order for us to issue you a non-conditional permit.

In addition, the holder sponsoring of my application may review my criminal history and driving records.
