Roadway Score:

Includes considerations such as the distance to the nearest signal or stop sign; number of lanes to cross; speed limit and whether and what kind of median is present.

Pedestrian Score:

Includes considerations such as the pedestrian crash history and the number and type of pedestrian generators in the area. Pedestrian generators include stores, restaurants, multifamily developments, bus stops, churches, schools, parks, etc. Also considers whether there is a facility in the area whose primary clientele is a mobility impaired community.

Community Score:

Includes considerations such as whether the requested location is recommended for a PHB as part of an adopted neighborhood, corridor, or master plan; is part of a school route or within an Environmental Justice Area.
