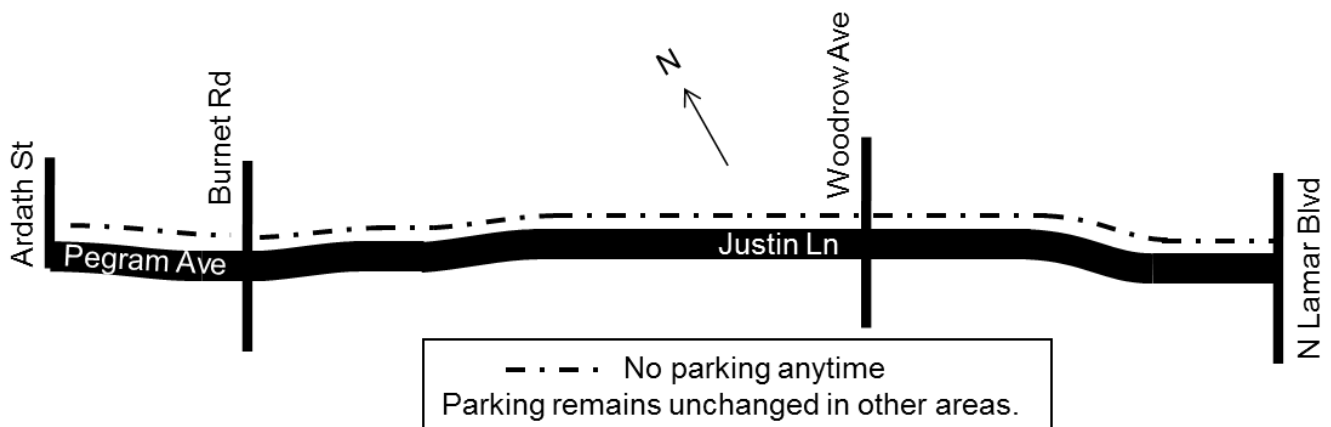
Dear Stakeholder, Property Owner, or Resident,

In order to improve safety for all modes of transportation, the City's Public Works Department and Transportation Department are implementing and improving a bicycle route system, as directed by the Austin City Council per **City Ordinance No. 20090611-075 (The Austin Bicycle Plan)**. Justin Lane from Burnet Road to North Lamar Boulevard and Pegrum Avenue from Burnet Road to Ardath Street are part of Route 22 of the City of Austin bicycle system. You are receiving this notification because you live on and/or own property adjacent to Justin Lane or Pegrum Avenue in Austin, Texas, and/or are a stakeholder in the area.

In coordination with routine street maintenance (road re-surfacing and re-striping), and to enhance mobility in the corridor for both motor vehicles and bicycles, the street striping will be reconfigured to remove parking from the bicycle lanes. To accomplish this reconfiguration, on-street motor vehicle parking will be prohibited on certain sections of Justin Lane and Pegrum Avenue. The corridor's safety and mobility, as well as the results of an on-street parking use analysis, were considered to determine these parking modifications:

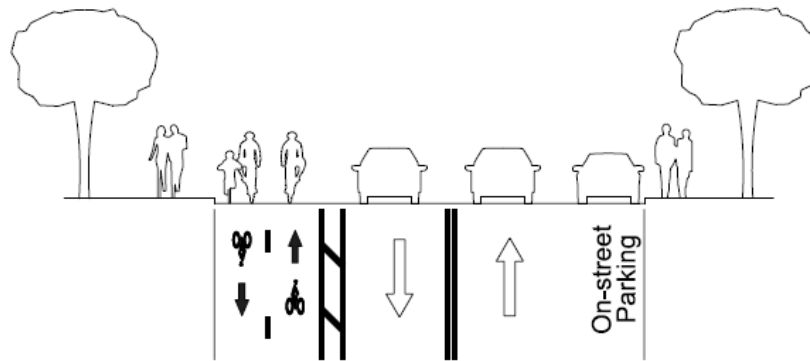
- **Justin Lane** (from Burnet Road to North Lamar Boulevard) – prohibit parking on the north side of the street.
- **Pegrum Ave** (from Burnet Road to Ardath Street) – prohibit parking on the north side of the street.

**Figure 1 – Justin Lane and Pegrum Avenue Planned No Parking Zones**



The dashed line in Figure 1 does not indicate the location of bicycle lanes; it only indicates the no parking areas. As indicated in Figure 1, Justin Lane and parts of Pegram Avenue will have permitted parking on only one side of the street. These locations will have bicycle lanes in both directions and will also have a parking lane on one side of the street as shown below in Figure 2.
