Dear Customer:

Austin Water is planning improvements to water and wastewater lines in your area. The project, known as the Fort Upper Basin Water and Wastewater Renewal Project, is expected to begin construction in March 2022 and take about 10 months to complete. The project will rehabilitate about 6,568 linear feet of wastewater lines and 650 linear feet of water lines.

The project will improve the integrity of the wastewater collection system, reduce the likelihood of sanitary sewer overflows and minimize the possibility of future environmental impacts. This project is part of Austin Water's efforts to replace aging and deteriorating water & wastewater infrastructure.
