

# CURRENT WATER CONSERVATION PENALTIES

June 1, 2024

Austin Water issues fines for violations of City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6-4. This document addresses water waste violations related to operating a residential or commercial irrigation system in manner not consistent with the requirements of Chapter 6-4. Violations of this chapter include watering on the wrong day, wrong time, causing run off greater than 50 feet, and misaligned and broken heads. This document provides information on the implementation of the Chapter 6-4 irrigation ordinances.

## ENFORCEMENT PROCESS

### 1. **Warning Notice of Violation (NOV)**

Upon the witness of a violation, staff will issue a warning NOV if an account holder has not received has not received a violation in the previous 365 days at the same address.

*Example:*

*Violation issued on June 1, 2021. Staff witness a violation on or before June 1, 2022, will result in fines being assessed.*

### 2. **Notice of Citation**

A second witnessing of a violation within the last year (365 days) will result in a Notice of Citation, which results in a monetary penalty. The violation hearing process can be found in the City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2-13.

## ASSESSMENT OF IRRIGATION PENALTIES

Within the City Council-approved penalty ranges for violation penalties, Austin Water will assess a specific penalty for irrigation-related violations similar to the current inclining block water rates. For residential and commercial irrigation violations, the gauge of use is based upon historical water use.

### **Residential Witnessed Irrigation Violations (§6-4-12(B)(1) to (B)(3); §6-4-13)**

Fines will be assessed in accordance with the ranges set for current drought restriction stage as set in City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2-13. When assessing a water conservation fine, staff will review the average usage for the three (3) most recent summer months (June – August when using meter data; July – September when using billing data) and determine which tier the customer falls in: top 1% of usage, top 3% of usage, top 5% of usage, top 10% of usage, and below the 90<sup>th</sup> percentage of use.

#### Residential usage tiers for penalty assessment

- Top 1% tier: ((maximum – minimum) x 100%) + minimum of range
- Top 3% tier: ((maximum – minimum) x 75%) + minimum of range
- Top 5% tier: ((maximum – minimum) x 50%) + minimum of range
- Top 10% tier: ((maximum – minimum) x 25%) + minimum of range
- Below 90% tier: minimum of range

Tiering information will be calculated annually by May 1 of each year. Staff will use updated tiering numbers effective June 1 of that year and remain in place until May 30 of the following year.

**Commercial Witnessed Irrigation Violations (§6-4-13)**

Given the complexity and wide range of property types, sizes, and usage demands for commercial and multifamily accounts, the penalty tiers apply only if an irrigation meter is onsite. If a commercial or multifamily customer has irrigation meter(s) onsite and the average summer usage is in the top 50 percent of irrigation use, the maximum penalties would be applied. If the customer’s average summer usage falls in the bottom 50 percent of irrigation or do not have an irrigation meter, the minimum penalty would be applied.

## ASSESSMENT OF OTHER WATER CONSERVATION PENALTIES

### General Regulations Violations § 6-4-11

Charity car wash not held at a certified car wash facility / Commercial cosmetic power wash efficiency violations / Ornamental fountain not recirculating / Foundation watering on the wrong day

- First citation: \$150
- Second citation: \$300
- Third citation: \$500
- Fourth and subsequent citations: \$1,000

Failure to connect to reclaim within 250 ft / Potable water for dust abatement / Cooling tower efficiency & safety requirements

- First citation: \$500
- Second citation: \$750
- Third citation: \$850
- Fourth and subsequent citations: \$1,000
