

Table Exercise 1: Instructions

Stage 3 Water Use Restrictions and the Lake Level that triggers the implementation of Stage 3 are already in place. We are exploring additional restrictions that could possibly be implemented during Stage 3 that will delay the onset of Stage 4. The Stage 3 Lake Level Trigger is set at 600,000 acre feet, and currently, there is no trigger for Stage 4.

Your assignment is to set lake level triggers that would require the observance of additional restrictions during Stage 3 and lake level triggers that would require the declaration of Stage 4.

In Column A, circle or write in the blank space provided, a lake level that would trigger additional restrictions in Stage3.

In Column B, circle or write in the blank space provided, a lake level that would trigger the declaration of Stage 4.

Table Exercise 2: Instructions

You have been asked to suggest additional restrictions that could be implemented during Stage 3 that may help delay the declaration of Stage 4. Please work with your table to determine what those additional restrictions might be. Stage 3 regulations are written in the leftmost column of your worksheet and Stage 4 regulations are written on the right. Your restrictions should fall somewhere in between, but new suggestions are welcome too.

Remember to consider affordability, enforceability, equitability, pumpage swings, landscape needs, etc. You may strike out or modify exemptions, but you may not add exemptions.
