Hydrant Mounted Meter Permit Process

A. Fire hydrant-mounted meter and backflow protection:

I. Renewal of fire hydrant-mounted water meter

1. The permittee is required to submit a Renewal application in Salesforce within thirty days of the permit expiration date to arrange for meter renewal.
2. A copy of a new backflow prevention assembly (RPZ) inspection certificate is required with a Renewal request.

Hydrant Mounted Water Permit

The permit is valid for 1 year from installation and will automatically expire. If water is still needed, the customer must reapply for a hydrant water meter prior to this permit expiration. The City requires that an approved reduced pressure backflow prevention assembly (RPZ) be installed and certified by a State of Texas-licensed backflow prevention assembly tester (BPAT) registered with Austin Water prior to obtaining water from a fire hydrant-mounted meter.
