UN-fun Facts about pet waste left on the ground:

- It's toxic to plants and can create dead spots on the lawn
- It can contain e-coli, roundworm, giardia, and other germs that make people and pets sick; some of these diseasecausing organisms remain infectious in soil for weeks or years

**CODE:** § 3-4-6: **DEFECATION BY A DOG OR CAT.** An owner or handler shall promptly remove and sanitarily dispose of feces left on public or private property by a dog or cat being handled by the person, other than property owned by the owner or handler of the dog or cat. **Maximum Fine:** \$500
