Central Texas Food Bank

21 counties

Freestone

- 46,000 clients / week McLennan
 - 66% client households have 1+ working adults
 - 93% are *not* homeless
- 45 million lbs of food /yr
 - 33% fresh produce
 - 22 million lbs of food rescue!
- \$1 = 4 meals / \$8 food / 5 lbs food


