9:30 Meet at McKinney Falls State Park (see directions)

9:30-10:30 Introduction to a watershed/scavenger hunt nature hike

10:30-12:00 Wade into the creek and find bugs that tell us about water quality

Optional (on your own): swim in Onion Creek (at your own risk)

WEDNESDAY

WEAR OLD CLOTHES AND SHOES YOU DON'T MIND GETTING DIRTY.

OPTIONAL: SWIMSUIT, TOWEL AND CHANGE OF CLOTHES

9:30 Meet at Whirlpool Cave (see directions)

9:30-10:00 Introduction to the Edwards Aquifer Recharge Zone

10:00-12:00 Caving in a Recharge Feature (Whirlpool Cave)

Optional (on your own): swim at Dick Nichols Park Pool

THURSDAY

WEAR SWIMSUIT OR SHORTS & WATER SHOES. BRING A TOWEL AND DRY BAG TO KEEP PERSONAL ITEMS DRY IN A CANOE

9:30 Meet at Barton Springs train depot (see directions)

9:30-9:50 Eliza Springs and the Barton Springs Salamander

9:50-10:30 Trash Timeline activity with Keep Austin Beautiful

10:30-12:00 Service-learning through creek/river clean-up while canoeing

Optional (on your own): wade in Barton Creek (at your own risk)


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CLEAN CREEK CAMP DIRECTIONS

July 14-16, 2015: Session B: Watershed & Aquifer

Day 1: McKinney Falls State Park, 5808 McKinney Falls Parkway



Option 1: Travel on Hwy 183 south of Ben White (near Hwy 71 and the airport). Turn right on McKinney Falls Parkway. Travel past the light on Burleson. The entrance to McKinney Falls State Park is located on the right.

Option 2: From IH35, travel east on William Cannon. William Cannon will dead-end into McKinney Falls Parkway. Turn left. The entrance to the park will be a little over a mile down the road on the left.

Meet at McKinney Falls State Park Headquarters / the Ranger Station near the park entrance.

BRING WATER SHOES. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO SWIM IN ONION CREEK AFTER CAMP, WEAR YOUR BATHING SUIT AND BRING A TOWEL.

Day 2: Whirlpool Cave, 7300 Latta Dr.



From Mopac

- West on Wm. Cannon
- Left on Brush Country Rd. at the light
- Go through intersection of Brush Country Rd. and Convict Hill Rd. (Brush Country Rd. turns into Latta Dr. underneath Mopac overpass)
- Pull off to right (over curb ramp) and park in dirt lot under Mopac overpass

From I-35

- West on William Cannon for several miles
- Go under the Mopac intersection
- Take the next left at Brush Country Rd.
- Go through intersection of Brush Country Rd. and Convict Hill Rd. (Brush Country Rd. turns into Latta Dr. underneath Mopac overpass)
- Pull off to right (over curb ramp) and park in dirt lot under Mopac overpass

YOU WILL GET VERY DIRTY CAVING. WEAR CLOTHES THAT ARE COOL BUT COVER YOUR LEGS AND ARMS IF POSSIBLE AND CLOSED TOED SHOES. SUGGESTED: BRING A SWIMSUIT IF YOU WANT TO SWIM AT DICK NICHOLS POOL AFTER CAMP AND A CLEAN CHANGE OF CLOTHES.

From Whirlpool Cave to Dick Nichols Park (restroom, picnic tables and swimming pool)

8011 Beckett Rd

- Left on Latta Ln
- Left on Convict Hill Rd
- Left on Beckett Rd
- Park is on the left

Day 3: Zilker Park/Barton Springs, 2101 Barton Springs Road

From Mopac:

- Take the Rollingwood exit
- Get on the Mopac access road heading north. It will curve into Barton Springs Road
- The entrance to the Springs will be on the right
- Meet near the Zilker Zephyr train depot/picnic pavilion (by playground)

From IH35:

- Go west on Riverside
- Turn left on Barton Springs Rd.
- Go past Lamar and Robert E. Lee Rd.
- Take the first left after Robert E. Lee Rd to Barton Springs
- Meet near the Zilker Zephyr train depot/picnic pavilion (by playground)
