

# MOBILITY BOND: LOCAL MOBILITY

E. YAGER LANE | Natures Bend to Jourdan Crossing Blvd

### **OVERVIEW**

This project will feature new pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure along a one-mile stretch of E. Yager Ln., between Natures Bend and Jourdan Crossing Blvd. Specific improvements include an 8 – 10 foot shared-use path on the south side of E. Yager Ln.; a new physically protected bike lane on the north side of E. Yager Ln.; and crossing improvements and the filling of sidewalk gaps at Shropshire Blvd., Thompkins Dr., Copperfield Dr., and Copperfield Park and the IDEA Public Schools driveway.

## **PROJECT PURPOSE**

This project will enhance pedestrian and bicycle safety for all users along this one-mile stretch of E. Yager Ln., between Natures Bend and Jourdan Crossing Blvd.

#### **FUNDING**

- \$2.8 Million
  - 2016 Mobility Bond
  - 2020 Mobility Bond
  - Sidewalk fee-in-lieu funding

#### **PROJECT SCHEDULE**

- Tentative construction start: May 2022
- Anticipated duration: 12 18 months
