



AUSTIN MOBILITY BONDS: LOCAL MOBILITY

Zilker Park Multimodal Access Improvements | Project ID: 11580.077

PROJECT PURPOSE

This project will enhance safety for all street users along this .7-mile stretch of Barton Springs Road and Stratford Drive. These improvements will dramatically improve pedestrian, bicycle and transit access to Zilker Park, Zilker Botanical Garden and the Austin Nature and Science Center.

OVERVIEW

In partnership with Austin Parks and Recreation, Austin Transportation and Capital Metro, Austin Public Works' Sidewalk Program will construct the improvements in three phases:

- **Phase 1**
 - Shared use path along Barton Springs Road between Loop 1 (MoPac) and the Zilker Botanical Garden entrance
 - Landscaped buffer between the shared use path and vehicular travel lanes
 - Improvements to MetroBus stops on both sides of Barton Springs Road in front of the Zilker Botanical Garden entrance, including new concrete pads, benches, and ADA-compliant connections to adjacent sidewalks
 - Pedestrian hybrid beacon and crosswalk across Barton Springs Road near the Zilker Botanical Garden entrance
- **Phase 2**
 - Shared use path along Stratford Drive between The Austin and Nature & Science Center entrance and just north of Barton Springs Road
- **Phase 3**
 - Shared use path connection between the Zilker Botanical Garden entrance and Phase 2 segment
