

## **Criminal History Records Check Disqualifying Criminal Offenses**

An individual has a disqualifying offense if the individual has been convicted of, or found not guilty of by reason of insanity, any of the disqualifying crimes listed in this paragraph in any jurisdiction a minimum of 10 years before the date of the individual's application for unescorted access authority, or while the individual has unescorted access authority.
