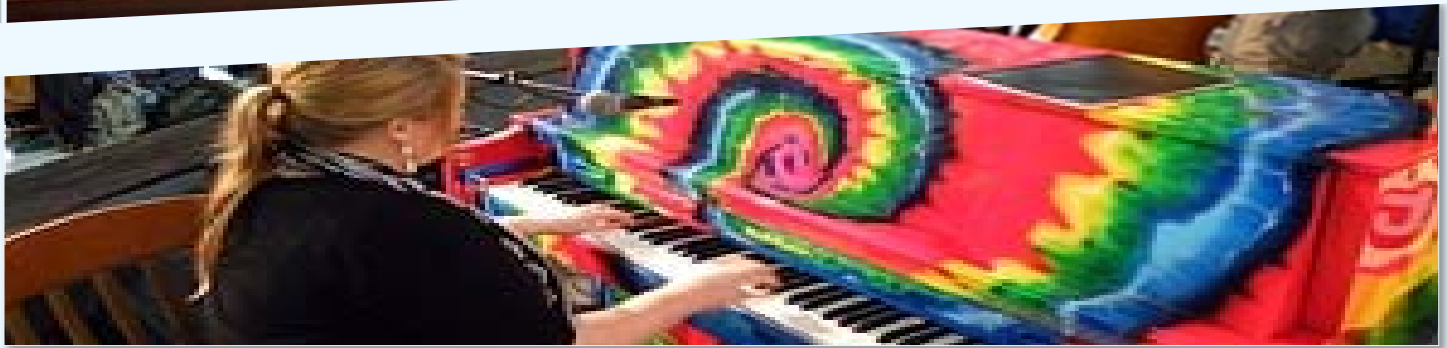




**Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA)

Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS):

City of Austin opened Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA) in 1999, after converting the former Bergstrom Air Force Base. Massive new construction was undertaken including the modern 700,000 square foot passenger terminal named after Barbara Jordan “Texas Civil Rights Activist” and a new air-control tower. With over 4,200 acres owned by the City of Austin, two (2) wide spaced parallel runways allowing simultaneous landings and/or takeoffs. Twenty-five (25) aircraft loading gates with connecting jet bridges and currently constructing a nine (9) gate expansion at the Barbara Jordan Terminal. Additionally, the South Terminal opened in 2017 providing three more gates. Over 13 million passengers traveled through Austin's airport in 2017. There 18 airlines operating at Austin-Bergstrom providing service to 70 nonstop destinations. The campus has a Hilton hotel (273 guest rooms) with an additional Hyatt Place hotel (139 guest rooms). Over \$280 million dollars in Capital Improvement are scheduled for multiple parking lot projects, a new Department of Aviation professional buildings and upgrades to make our traveling customers feel that unique “Austin, Texas Hospitality”. Additionally, ABIA is ranked 5th among the 10 Best Domestic Airports by Travel + Leisure magazine and 3rd amongst the World’s Best Airports for Customer Service 2016 in North America by the Airports Council International’s (ACI) Airport Service Quality customer survey.

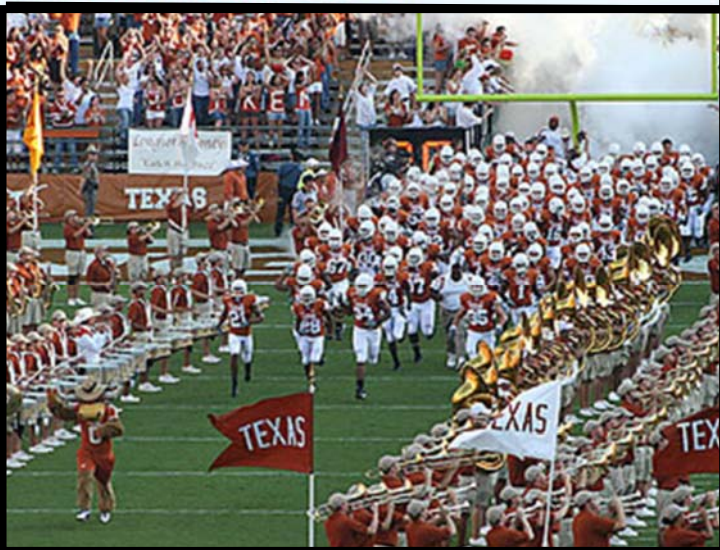

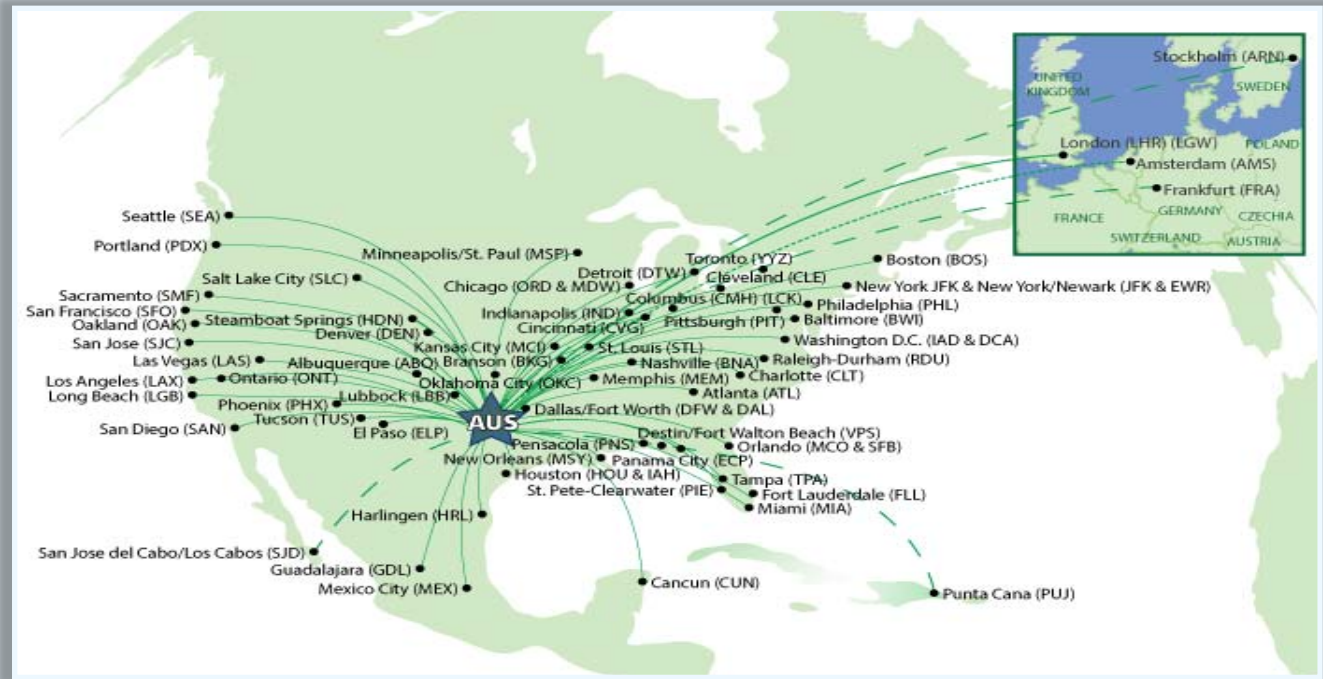

Career Opportunity



Austin Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA) is undertaking a major capital improve campaign to include a nine (9) gates expansion, a new 6,000 space parking garage, new 75,000 square foot Administration Building, new General Aviation facilities, numerous major tenant renovations, and third party developments. In addition to the Capital Improvement Plans (CIP), ABIA is undertaking a new Master Plan that will provide an expansion program of new major airport projects that be over \$1.5 Billion over the next 10 years. The Division Manager position will provide better service to City of Austin Department partners, ABIA tenants, and regulatory agencies with major infrastructure decisions for the airport, and ensure business partners are protected during the design and construction on the airport.





Minimum Qualifications

Graduation with Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major coursework in Architecture, Engineering, or a related field, plus seven (7) years of experience in a field related to the job, including three (3) years of experience in a supervisory capacity. Licensed Professional Engineer (PE) in the State of Texas or Registered Architect by the Texas Board of Architectural Examiners.

Preferred Qualifications

In addition to the requirements of the City of Austin Project Division Manager of Airport planning and Development Job Description, there will be a strong emphasis on large facility, security, safety and managing projects within a 24-hour facility catering to the public. All of these items are reflected in the Preferred Qualifications as followed:

1. Planning and development experience of a large campus like facility that operates on a 24-hour basis.
2. Planning and management of large Capital Expansion programs at an airport or similar facility.
3. Management of projects in a high security area.
