Record breaking passenger count this March at Austin's airport

March 2015

AUSTIN, TEXAS – March 2015 set a new passenger record with 1,006,899 traveling through Austin-Bergstrom. Events in Austin, including the SXSW festival, contributed to the monthly passenger record being set and bringing ABIA its second 1 million passenger month in airport history. The previous monthly record of 1,006,417 was set in July 2014. Austin's airport has experienced passenger growth 62 of the last 63 months, since January 2010.

Passenger Activity: Total passenger traffic for March 2015 was a monthly airport record 1,006,899, up 7% compared to March 2014. March 2015 enplanements totaled 502,130, up 6.5%.
